Academic Search Premier

A multi-discipline database that has access to newspaper, magazine and journal articles.

Banco De Contenido aula Planeta

Spanish-language database with access to articles, images, videos, animations, sounds and interactive media.

Biography Reference Bank

Articles about more than a half-million people, most in full text, from around the world, both living and dead.

Britannica Online Academic

The complete encyclopedia as well as related websites, multimedia, periodical articles and more.

Country Reports

This database offers overviews of worldwide countries, including government information.

Creative Bug

This database is your go-to resource for high-quality, on-trend arts and crafts instructional videos.

Digital Theater Plus

This database offers live performances that are accompanied by a range of invaluable educational resources for illustration, explanation and critical reflection.

Digital Video Collection

EBSCOhost All Research Databases

Provides access to over 20 databases offering periodical abstracts and full-text articles.

Ebook Central

This is an eBook database that covers all academic subject areas. The collection currently includes more than 80,000 titles.

Explora for Educators

Full-text articles from thousands of academic journals and professional magazines on a wide variety of educational topics to support educator professional development. Includes lesson plans, curriculum standards and more.

Discover full-text articles from thousands of magazines, journals and newspapers,

Gale Ebooks

This is a database of ebooks - encyclopedias, almanacs, and specialized reference sources - for multidisciplinary research.

GreenFILE

Collection of scholarly, government and general interest titles cover global climate change, green building, pollution, sustainable agriculture, renewable energy, recycling and more. Full text for more than 13,000 Open Access items.

JSTOR - Scholarly Journal Archive

This database contains extensive back issues of core journals in the humanities, social sciences and sciences. The journals have been digitized, starting with the very first issues, many of which reach back to the 1800s.
