The session includes focused instruction on passing free balls, down balls, attacks and serves, along with overhand passing for greater ball control. The clinic concludes with 30 minutes of game play, giving athletes the chance to put their new skills into action in a live setting.

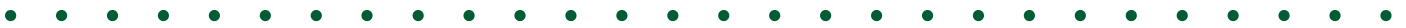
Superhero Academy

Students will spend their days as "makers," gaining full access to WRA's world-class Wang Innovation Center (WIC). Here, they will master a sophisticated suite of professional tools, including 3D printing, laser cutting, CNC milling, UV printing, artificial intelligence, electronics and much more. Whether they are experimenting with garment sublimation or prototyping complex robotic components, campers will be guided by expert instructors to transform their boldest ideas into tangible realities.

Beyond the lab, the curriculum extends into the heart of the industry with exclusive field trips to local innovation hubs and scientific businesses, providing a firsthand look at how the skills they are learning shape the future. As a residential camp, the experience continues long after the school day ends; students living on campus will enjoy the independence of dormitory life and a vibrant schedule of evening social activities designed to build lasting friendships and a collaborative community.
